<p>Decon Shower System</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Must be able for 2 people to set up in less than 30 minutes with running water · Flow rate adequate for multiple victim decontamination · Internal viewing window for medical personnel to view patients as they decon, to ensure proper decon, if medical staff are not able to otherwise monitor decon activity (optional) · Decon capabilities for ambulatory and non-ambulatory patients · Containment berm system for hazardous materials run-off · Ability to capture and retain post decon contaminated run off (external bladder) · Process and equipment to collect patients' clothing and contaminated items · Privacy panels · RECOMMENDED but not mandatory: · Fixed or hand held sprayer for effective decon · Valve connector for warm water supply · Carts as needed for supplies · Roller system and backboards, or mass casualty litters and all terrain wheels for non-ambulatory decon -One waterproof lighting set (3 light set) 			Ea	1	1	1	1
